Theresa VILLIERS : My priorities for Chipping Barnet

Supporting local business and economic recovery

Theresa is a great supporter of local business and high streets in Barnet. She fought to save our historic Market and return it to its newly improved site. Theresa has campaigned for our local Post Offices, eg in East Barnet. Under threat under Labour, local post offices have received increased investment under this Conservative-led Government, with improved facilities and services.

All local businesses have received

a £2000 cut in jobs taxes and pay no jobs tax at all when employing under 21s. This is only possible because the Conservative long term economic plan is working. There are 1.85 million more people in work since the last election. We have halved the deficit and capped welfare so we have been able to cut income tax and freeze fuel duty to help hard working people. All this would be at risk under Labour

Many businesses say infrastructure is key. Theresa successfully campaigned for improvements to local transport, eg the Northern Line, and is pushing BT to connect more people to fast broadband.

Delivering first class schools & skills

Barnet has some of the best state schools in the country, with over 90% graded 'good' or 'outstanding' by Ofsted. Theresa helped our secondary schools gain academy status. She lobbied Government for funds for a major rebuild of Cromer Road School. The Conservatives have toughened the curriculum and exam standards are now more rigorous to give young people the skills they need.

Theresa is also a strong supporter of apprenticeships. The Conservatives have delivered 2m apprenticeships and will provide 3m more in the next Parliament.

Theresa backed the new free school in Brunswick Park – the UK's first Greek Orthodox secondary school – and wants more free schools for Barnet. Labour oppose these new schools.



Crime down by a fifth

Crime is down by a fifth under the Conservatives. Theresa called for a reduction in police red tape so they could spend more time on the beat. Reforms since 2010 have saved 4.5m hours of police time. Ward police teams in Barnet have been kept, despite Labour's deficit. Theresa fought to save Barnet Police Station.

- ✓ Labour's 'Mansion Tax' on homes could apply to properties valued at £1m but the threshold might be lower
- ✓ Labour would have to re-value every home so many families would pay more council tax

- ✓ Theresa strongly opposes Labour's homes tax which discriminates against her constituents
